Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut N.V. / *France, Champagne*

£100 £200

On the nose this has beautiful aromatic complexity, ripe fruit and spicy aromas, hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. The palate a subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and notes of fresh walnut.

Ruinart Blanc de Blancs N.V. / *France, Champagne*

£160

This is a light, fresh and fruity wine, filled with aromas of apple, ripe pear and a touch of lime. The palate is seasoned with subtle spices and white pepper, and hints of honeysuckle and grapefruit. It will develop nutty flavours if you're patient enough to age it.

Dom Perignon 2015 / *France, Champagne*

£320

A cacophony of scents: smoke, spices, saffron, sweet yellow pepper, mustard seed and rainwater. Very impressive that it should be so vibrant at such a young age. The palate is creamy and dense, yet fresh and precise, with a composed, smooth mousse. The finish is majestic, with earthy, Meursault-like flavours, mineral and charcoal. This is stunning.

Cristal 2006 / *France, Champagne*

From the warm 2006 vintage, this has a rich bouquet with hints of zesty fruit, lilies and light toasted hazelnuts. As it develops in the glass the fruit aromas become more intense and complex. The palate confirms the delicate fruit with a deep, ripe flavour and silky texture, finishing crisply with a pure, mineral balance. As a young wine this is already deliciously balanced and charming, and promises to be a magnificent Champagne in full maturity.

Bollinger La Grand Année 2015 / *France, Champagne*

The scent is beautifully house typical, dominated by apricot, almond, hazelnut and a smoky sophisticated intensity as from a newly lit outdoor fire. The attack is stunningly intense and the weight in the oral cavity leaves nothing left to wish for. Resilient energy and fullness are combined with greatness.

Krug Grande Cuvée N.V. / *France, Champagne*

£350

A non-vintage like no other. The oak adds toast, spicy notes and weight to the wine and gives the palate a fantastic, deep richness. Perfectly balanced with citrus, hazelnut, brown bread flavours all playing a part. Richly deserves its luxury status.

Pol Roger Sir Winston Churchill 2015 / *France, Champagne*

The nose opens with notes of spices and pepper. A good intensity of black fruit follows, showing the fine concentration and density of the wine. The complexity is obvious: a bouquet of dried fruit and hazelnut overlaid with notes of exotic fruits. On the palate, candied fruit notes accompany hints of pastries, brioche and cocoa, broad and mouth-filling. Full bodied and generous, the wine culminates with terrific length

Marchese Antinori Blanc de Blancs Franciacorta N.V.

/ Italy, Lombardia

The nose is immediately fragrant with floral and fruity notes which recall apples and white peaches. The palate is distinguished by a liveliness and freshness accompanied by much balance and a notable elegance. Perfect served with hors d'oeuvres, as an aperitif, and with fish. Its vibrant crispiness make it a perfect wine as an after dinner drink as well.

J. Laurens Limoux Cremant Graiménous Brut 2022

/ France, Languedoc

This Crémant is brilliant with a pleasantly gentle fizz. Bright and citrusy, with just a hint of yeasty savouriness overlaying the lovely sweet fruit. (V)

Luvignac Picpoul de Pinet 2023 / *France, Languedoc-Rousillon*

There's almost a whiff of the Etang de Thau itself in this wine, a seawater-and-sunlight richness, while the palate is rich, full, penetrating, zesty and long: a worthy standard-bearer for the region. (V)

Boutinot 'La Fleur Solitaire' Cotes Du Rhone Blanc 2023

/ France, Rhone

Proper white Côtes du Rhône; fresh, medium-bodied, vinous. The nose is pretty and delicate, with a waft of fennel tops and hints of hedgerow flowers. The flavours are nuanced and refined rather than overt. Careful use of oak adds texture and structure without masking the freshness of this very drinkable white. (V)

Domaine Du Montillet Condrieu Les Grandes Chaillées 2023

/ France, Rhone

£90

The essence of Viognier, elegant, with a broad and complex aromatic profile that reveals notes of stone fruit and yellow fruit, followed by hints of orange blossom in the background. On the palate, it is rich and round, powerful and elegant with a delicately viscous texture typical of Condrieu wines. It is fresh and well-balanced with a long and floral finish. It is a wine capable of aging very well but can be enjoyed now.

Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis 2023 / *France, Burgundy*

One of the leading producers in the region, producing a first class example of true Chablis. Notes of lemon and white peach on the nose lead onto a palate that is clean and rounded, dry and expressive.

Domaine Des Deux Roches Pouilly-Fuisse Vieilles Vignes 2022

/ France, Burgundy

£90

This Pouilly Fuissé Vieilles Vignes is deep gold with an intense brioche aroma and hints of stone fruits and flowers. It has a complex palate of green apples, citrus, creamy oak notes, and an impressive finish.

Domaine Chanson Meursault 2022 / *France, Burgundy*

£190

A pale golden colour, accompanied by a rich and complex aroma of white flowers, mineral, and citrus fruits. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied, with a perfect balance of acidity and fruitiness, and a long, satisfying finish.

Domaine Fontaine-Audon Sancerre Terrior Silex 2022 / *France, Loire*

Wonderfully fresh and mineral-driven, with intense crisp orchard fruits and beautifully balanced acidity followed by a touch of melon ripeness to the fruit.

Peth Wetz Estate Riesling 2024 / *Germany, Rheinhessen*

A dry Riesling with a delicate fragrance of white peaches, apricot and juicy pears. Classic in both expression and elegance. (V)

Olivier Zeter Sauvignon Blanc Fumé 2022 / *Germany, Pfalz*

‘A very serious Sauvignon with some honeysuckle and weight but quite enough freshness. Green grassy aromas before the richness imbued by the winemaking kicks in. Very appetising. When Germany produces a really interesting, well-balanced Sauvignon, you know the wine world is truly changing and we all have to run to keep up. A hint of reduction is encouraged.’ – Jancis Robinson (V)

Spain

Xion Albariño 2022 / *Spain, Rias Baixas*

Intense and delicious nose of white fresh fruit with fine touches of citrus fruits that give it an attractive sensation of freshness. The luscious acidity and the persistent aromas provides a long and pleasant final. (V)

Attis Lias Finas Albariño 2023 / *Spain, Rias Baixas*

The Attis ‘Lias Finas’ reminds us why we fell in love with Albariño in the first place. It pours a bright, fresh, silver-lemon colour with a hint of green at the edge, and is dry yet full of succulent, juicy fruit, glistening with grapefruit, apricot, white peach, chalk dust and salt flakes. ‘Lias Finas’ means ‘fine lees’ and indicates that the wine was aged on its lees for 6 months, giving the wine extra body and richness. (V)

Italy

Pieropan Soave Classico 2023 / *Italy, Veneto*

On the nose it has aromas of almond blossoms and marzipan, with a touch of citrus. On the palate it is rounded and has flavours of ripe fruit perfectly balanced by a fresh, clean acidity that enhances its long length.

Alpha Zeta Pinot Grigio 2024 / *Italy, Veneto*

Lovely weight and a silky texture on the palate, with hints of fresh red fruits and a zesty acidity finishing with a dry, impressive length. (V)

Demarie Roero Arneis 2023 / *Italy, Piedmont*

Full-bodied, robust and intense, composite and delicate. Floral as well as fruity nuances of Scotch broom, camomile, peach and apricot. The pallet is dry, palatable and pleasantly harmonic. Fresh and persistent with a slightly almond aftertaste. (V)

Antinori Castello della Sala Bramito Chardonnay 2022

/ Italy, Umbria

The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine in its own right, with a tautly structured palate and aromas of apples, citrus and toast.

Japan

Château Mercian Koshu Sur Lie 2023 / *Japan, Yamanashi*

Refreshing aromas of citrus fruits such as lemon, lime, sudachi and pear. Present acidity is accented by pleasant astringency extracted from the skin of Koshu grapes. (V)

Australia & New Zealand

Xanadu Circa 77 Chardonnay 2022 / *Australia, Margaret River*

This bright and refreshing wine offers aromas and flavours of pear, grapefruit and nectarine with underlying hints of toast. It is medium-bodied with a creamy mouthfeel and a crisp, lingering finish. (V)

Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc 2024

/ New Zealand, Marlborough

Classic passionfruit aromas are the first to emerge, followed by a little white peach and crisp pear. The palate is generous yet refreshing, layered with elderflower and hints of citrus blossom. Beautiful! (V)

South Africa

Cederberg Five Generations Chenin Blanc 2020

/ South Africa, Cederberg Mountains

A complex Chenin blanc expressing a sensational bouquet of citrus blossom, roasted almonds and orange peel. A great balance between oak and fruit on palate showing baked apple and marmalade with a rich and creamy finish.

Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2018 / *South Africa, Hemel-en-Aarde*

A tight, mineral wine with classic Hamilton Russell Vineyards length and complexity. Unusually prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers followed by a long, refreshing finish.

Herrenhoff Sand & Lime Reserve Pinot Gris 2020 / Austria, Styria

I want craftsmanship perfection in wine, without additives, in the spirit of natural wine. As it used to be – real, but with modern understanding and without esoteric swirling; Only this is wine from Herrenhoff. Delicately orange/pink in colour, tangerine peel on the nose with light grapefruit notes on the palate. Oak is used to give the wine texture rather than imparting any toasty notes. As Gottfried says; “fine and elegant, not opulent.” (V)

Boutinot ‘La Côte Sauvage’ Cairanne 2021 / France, Rhone

A serious, opulent and complex example of cru Cairanne. This is rich, intense and drenched in dark red fruits. With morello cherry and a touch of cinnamon spice on the nose, soft dark plummy fruit, liquorice, chocolate, a hint of black tea on the palate, this wine is full flavoured and smooth with supple tannins. A rich, savoury satisfying mouthful that shows greater elegance with air. (V)

Ferraton Châteauneuf du Pape, Le Parvis 2017 / France, Rhone

A dense wine, with notes of sour cherries, plum, roasted coffee and leather. Fleshy, with fine and rounded tannins that coat the palate and carry on through the long, savoury finish. (V)

Jean Luc Colombo La Divine Côte Rôtie 2019 / France, Rhone

The roasted slope -- Côte-Rôtie has very steep mica schist terraces from both Côte Blonde and Côte Brune soil slopes. Magic and eternal, “La Divine” combines the intensity and freshness of Syrah with the floral-driven Viognier to produce a truly divine wine! Superb smoky nose of exotic spices and jammy black fruit. Dense flavours prevail; a very complex, concentrated wine.

Beautiful blend of vanilla aroma from the oak barrels and rich ripe red fruits. A smooth attack, it develops into a more powerful, elegant taste with a long finish.

Château La Fleur Penin St Emilion Grand Cru 2022

/ France, St. Emilion, Bordeaux

The nose is fruity, racy and offers a fine complexity. It reveals notes of wild cassis, blackberry, small notes of small ripe wild black fruits associated with touches of crushed raspberry, small crushed berries, liquorice as well as very discreet hints of sweet spices and a subtle hint of pepper. On the palate this wine expresses notes of juicy cassis, juicy blackberry and touches of raspberry. Good length and persistence.

Château Deyrem Valenti Cru Bourgeois 2022

/ France, Margaux, Bordeaux

There are places where wine is the lifeblood. The Château Deyrem-Valentin in Margaux is such a place. The home of great vintages classed as “Grands crus”, this estate dates back to 1730. This Deyrem Valentin has a ripe and generous bouquet that calms down in the glass, revealing attractive cranberry and blackcurrant fruit laced with pressed violets and iris. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, lovely pure-black fruit with just a hint of graphite.

Château Batailley 5ème Cru Classé 2016 / France, Pauillac, Bordeaux

The 2016 Batailley is deep garnet-coloured. It rolls up with gregarious blackcurrant jelly, plum preserves, and cedar chest scents, plus touches of violets, dark chocolate, and graphite. The light to medium-bodied palate is bright, breezy, and refreshing. It delivers crunchy, youthful fruit and a firm, grainy frame, finishing on a lingering mineral note.

RED WINE

France

Château Kirwan 3ème Cru Classé 2017 / France, Margaux, Bordeaux

In the glass, this Chateau Kirwan wine from Margaux displays an intense red colour and gives off quite a grand palette of freshly ripened dark berry. The attack in the mouth is bold and vibrant. The mid-palate is fleshy, almost juicy all upon very elegant, distinguished tannins with a refined grain. The tannic structure and balance of this wine reveals Cabernet Sauvignon that is perfectly concentrated and gradually ripened. The fruity finish is persistent. This wine is very nicely balanced on the whole. It is indeed a great Margaux classic.

Château Leoville-Barton 2ème Cru Classé 2006

/ France, Saint Julien, Bordeaux

Not surprisingly, this wine is masculine and super-rich, with a denser, more complete and full-bodied style than its sibling, Langoa Barton. Some toasty vanillin is apparent in the black currant aromas intermixed with tobacco leaf, cedar, and spice box. The wine is full-bodied and has a boatload of tannin, not unusual for this estate, as well as an impressively pure, long finish. Everything is here, but this wine, made with uncompromising vision.

Château Palmer, 3ème Cru Classé 2008 / France, Margaux, Bordeaux

A stunning success for the vintage, and possibly the Margaux of the year, this wine, which achieved 13.5% natural alcohol, is a blend of 51% Merlot, 41% Cabernet Sauvignon and 8% Petit Verdot. Loads of barbecue smoke, liquorice, incense, blackberry, new saddle leather and forest floor notes jump from the glass of this dense, purple-coloured wine. Extraordinarily intense and full-bodied, with plenty of tannin, but not the formidable structure of the 2010, this is going to be one of the longest-lived wines of 2008. It is full, rich, layered, and should be reasonably approachable with 3-4 years of bottle age, and will also keep for 30+ years. Robert Parker (May 2011)

Domaine Bernard Métrât Fleurie, La Roilette, Vieilles Vignes 2023

/ France, Beaujolais

From the parcel's oldest vines, this is invariably more concentrated than the standard (non-Vieilles Vignes) Roilette. There's an attractive savoury note to the nose, as well as the ethereal aromas of flowers and violets synonymous with the best wines of Fleurie. On the palate, expect fresh acidity and fine, chalky tannins. The 2017 is all the more impressive in light of the hail and drought that made for such a challenging vintage.

Henri De Villamont Gevrey-Chambertin 2017 / France, Burgundy

Very light brick colour with a light brown rim. Forrest floor, black truffles, dried figs and strawberry nose. Fantastic palate that starts with overripe strawberry and white currant and continues with an acidic and surprisingly full bodied earthyness and finishes with morels and truffles. Great length.

Domaine Alain Micholet Nuits St Georges Vieilles Vignes 2018

/ France, Burgundy

The Domaine Alain Michelot Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes displays all the richness garnered from 45 year old vines. Powerful, aromatic and with wonderful texture this wine offers complex flavours of blackberry, blackcurrant and smoke leading on to a long, elegant and flavoursome finish.

Germany

Peth Wetz Estate Spätburgunder 2023 / Germany, Rheinhessen

Notes of bright red cherry, blueberry, clove, black tea leaf and cinnamon are consistent from the nose to the palate where they are met by crisp acidity and round tannins. The complexity of this wine will continue to evolve over time. (V)

Spain

Ontanon Reserva 2015 / Spain, Rioja

Aromas of bramble fruit with spice and lightly floral notes. On the palate plum and blackberry fruit flavours combine with ample acidity, minerality and earthy notes.

Sangarida 'Pico Tuerto' Mencia 2020 / Spain, Bierzo

Fine and complex nose with ripe red and black fruit, spicy notes and mineral touches. Full bodied with a magnificent velvety tannic structure. The palate is long and elegant. The aromas gain in complexity and intensity with a long persistence.

Greece

Thymiopoulos, Xinomavro 2021 / Greece, Naoussa

Belying the pale colour, this wine packs in plenty of character, offering dark fruit, tobacco and black olive flavours alongside a bracing acidity and a bold tannic structure. Utterly compelling.

Italy

Brusafer Pinot Nero Superiore DOC 2021 / Italy, Trentino

Lifted aromas of ripe cherry, red berry and lightly spiced notes. The palate has raspberry and redcurrant fruit, with herbal notes and fine tannins. Supple and velvety balanced by fresh acidity and a long, delicate finish.

Monte del Frà Valpolicella Classico Superiore Ripasso 2021

/ Italy, Veneto

Deep ruby red in colour, the nose is of cherries, plums, liquorice, pepper and cinnamon. The palate is dry and full with good fruit and well balanced with soft tannins. A powerful but elegant wine.

Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva 2021 / Italy, Tuscany

The nose shows notes of ripe red fruit, wild cherries and sensations of dried wild flowers along with spicy aromas of cinnamon and a pleasurable balsamic finish. The palate is balanced, savoury and vibrant with a long and persistent aftertaste which brings back the wine's ample spicy aromas and flavours.

RED WINE

Italy

Demarie Barolo DOCG 2019 / Italy, Piedmont

The wine has a beautiful colour that ranges from garnet red with orange reflections, showing ageing. The wine's aroma is intense and extraordinarily complex, with lovely notes of violets and vanilla. When tasting the wine, you experience a dry, full-bodied and balanced palate.

Tignanello 2020 / Italy, Tuscany

This is deep, rich, dark and fragrant on the nose, with notes of berry fruit, spice, oak and summer flowers. Full-bodied and powerful on the palate, black fruit from the Cabernets dominates the attack at present, but with silky Sangiovese making its presence felt too. Very impressive, and almost impenetrable at this youthful stage, this has great fruit, depth, complexity, acidity and fine yet grippy tannins.

Lebanon

Château Musar 2018 / Lebanon, Bekaa Valley

The 2018 vintage has a deep garnet colour in the glass with dried cherries and mature red fruits on the nose. The palate is rich and concentrated with cranberries, raisins, and dates; there is good acidity with fine tannins. It has an enticing smoky, dusty fruit with soft liquorice undertones and at 6 years of age upon release, it is already developed and mature.

Australia

Xanadu Circa 77 Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 / Australia, Margaret River

Vibrant, characteristic aromas of blackcurrants, ripe briary fruits, and mocha entwined with hints of spicy, toasty oak. The full-bodied palate is packed full of juicy ripe blackberries, cassis and dark chocolate characters. A generous wine with supple lingering finish. (V)

The Black Craft Shiraz 2023 / Australia, Barossa Valley

A compelling, dark and rich chocolatey beast with intense savoury flavours of thick blackberry compote, black pepper and typical iron-rich beefy flavours. Not a hint of jam here, no sweetness, this is serious Shiraz for grown-ups with balanced acidity, a touch of cocoa powder in the finish and tremendous length. (V)

North America

Domaine Drouhin 'Roserock' Pinot Noir 2021 / USA, Oregon

A pop of cacao and cola leaps from the glass, evolving into a fresh, pure nose suggesting crushed spices, bright red fruit, and a hint of blackberry bramble. The essence of sweet dried cherries is complemented by silky tannins and aromatic depth, highlighted by cranberry and plum. It's approachable now, and the light grip upfront hints at its potential longevity in the cellar.

Opus One 2018 / USA, California, Napa Valley

Power and concentration from the start but with a lovely vein of cool blue fruits and an invigoratingly fresh core. Dark chocolate, coffee, blueberries and pomegranate combine to give a seductive nose and follow through on the palate with an immediate burst of juicy acidity and plush tannins. Layered and nuanced, the texture is striking, elegant and precise with juice that his the side of the mouth supported by oak spice that gently frames the overall feeling giving balance. Abundant in a sense but also reigned in making you want another glass straight away.

South America

Pulenta La Flor Malbec 2021 / Argentina, Mendoza

Well-balanced with the intensely concentrated dark fruit notes and velvet-like tannins. Black cherry and plum dominate on the nose and palate, accompanied by a subtle and well-integrated cedar note which persists long into the finish.

South Africa

Anthonji Rupert OPTIMA 2021 / South Africa, Franschhoek

The palate is all about texture: silky, velvety, smooth and simultaneously plush. Ripe plums, hedgerow fruit, cocoa, cedar and spice, cigar box flavours make for an enveloping mouthful. Complex, elegant and beautifully integrated, the oak is seamlessly balanced with the fruit. Lingering & harmonious with not a single element out of place.
